

The Social Care Traineeship will be carried in the Municipal Social Care Service. The institution organizes free time activities designed for children between 5 and 12 years old in several neighbourhoods of Murcia. Activities include workshops, excursions, sports etc.

Students tasks would include:

- supporting monitors during the free time activities
- preparation of activities before going out
- taking part actively in the workshops
- joining the coordination meetings with the monitors
- filling a questionnaire at the end of each activity
- joining a Red Cross Workshop as a part of their training.

Interns would have all transportation costs in the city covered. Students would have a flexible timetable from Monday to Friday, according to the service necessities.

The Environment Traineeship would be carried in the Murcia City Council. Students would do the fieldwork to gather acoustic information and would create cartography maps related to noise, biodiversity and mobility.

Key Tasks:

- working on updating the Noise Strategic Map of the Municipality of Murcia (year 2016)
- working on developing the Action Plan Against Noise Pollution in the Municipality of Murcia
- acoustic measurement and vehicle capacity measurement
- entering measurement data in modelling programmes
- entering measurement data in GIS
- working with geographic information sources
- collecting environmental information through the fieldwork
- updating the environmental mapping of the Municipality of Murcia
- updating the cartography basis of the Municipality (buildings, roads, rails, green areas etc.).

Benefits for the graduate

Interns would acquire following skills:

- advanced use of a sonometer and entering data in modelling software
- developing acoustic models to create strategic noise maps
- developing action plans against noise pollution
- advanced knowledge of GIS (editing, work with GIS databases and map algebra).

Personal Specification

Preferably a technical degree (engineering) or a degree in biology, environmental sciences or geography, with basic knowledge of acoustics and GIS (SLM management, arcgis, arcview-gvsig). **Language requirements**: basic level of Spanish or intermediate English is required.

The Drama Traineeship will be carried in the Teatro Circo, a municipal theatre located in the centre of Murcia. Since it was opened in 2011, the theatre has hosted more than 400 shows joined by over 270.000 spectators. Teatro Circo presents its own shows, however, most of the shows are produced by national and international companies.

During the last three years Teatro Circo has become a modern and open institution known by demanding audience which is looking for high quality productions.

During the traineeship students tasks would include:

- supporting the theatre production by getting on with companies
- supporting the theatre alternative activities (exhibitions, audience management, trainings etc.)
- supporting the pedagogical project
- external communication
- ticketing.

Students would have a flexible timetable from Monday to Sunday, always with two days off, in accordance with the needs of the theatre.

Each student would be supported by a mentor. The mentors would help students in getting involved into the local community with providing them opportunities to join several activities.
